ALL THE WEEKEND ACTION

Premier Division

PREMIER Division leaders Hornchurch, who had won five of their six away games, travelled to fifth-placed Lewes, the only side in the division with a 100 per cent home record, on Saturday.

And it was Urchins who came away with a comprehensive 4-0 victory to maintain their place at the head of affairs. After a goalless first half, Martin Tuohy took his tally for the season into double figures with a penalty double, after 49 and 66 minutes. Lewis Smith made it three in the 78th minute and Jonathan Hunt added a late free-kick.

Hornchurch have played more matches than the teams chasing them but the old adage has it that points in the bag are worth more than games in hand and that was certainly the case on Saturday as the five clubs between third to seventh in the table failed to collect a point (though that included Hendon, who were on FA Cup duty).

Second-placed Billericay, however, maintained their excellent form and what is now the division's only unbeaten home record with a 4-2 victory over Canvey. They are a point behind Urchins with two games in hand.

The islanders started the day in ninth place but a win would have lifted them above their hosts and it was anybody's game until the closing stages.

Jay May scored early in each half for Billericay but equalisers came from Rob King in the 16th minute and Jason Hallett in the 74th. David Knight put Blues ahead for the third time in the 78th minute and Rob Swaine headed the clincher.

The other side to benefit from the stumbles among the next group of clubs were Met Police, who climbed from eighth to third. It was a tale of two penalties in six minutes at Imber Court: Ty Smith took his chance from the spot on the hour and Tommy Whitnell hit a post with his effort shortly afterwards, condemning Cray to a 1-0 defeat.

Lowestoft, third at the start of play, went down 2-1 in an entertaining game at Tooting, who thus chalked up their first home win in the league. Wade Small put the Terrors ahead shortly before half-time and Adrian Forbes equalised with 20 minutes left. Tooting then survived some heavy pressure before Andre

McCollin sunk the Trawlerboys in the 85th minute.

Bury must have expected to improve on their seventh place when Kieran Leabon gave them a first-minute lead at Harrow. But he missed a good chance to make it 2-0 and a goal in each half from Jon-Jo Bates earned Harrow a 2-1 win.

There must be something in the Hastings air that disagrees with Horsham. Last season they had to play with eight men for the last 20 minutes but somehow held out to win 3-2. Yesterday they had only two players dismissed but could not escape the consequences as they crashed to a 5-0 defeat.

Kenny Pogue's sixth-minute strike was all that separated the sides until Helge Orome was given his marching orders in the 64th minute. Calum McGeehan joined him in the dressing room two minutes later, having conceded a penalty which Lee Carey converted. It then turned into a rout, with Pogue, Jamie Crellin and Zac Attwood completing the nap hand.

Richard Jolly netted twice as Wealdstone moved closer to the leaders with a 3-0 victory at Aveley. He opened his account in the tenth minute, David Hicks made it 2-0 midway through the second half and Jolly notched his 13th of the season, ten of them in the league, shortly afterwards.

Wingate took an early lead through Ahmet Rifat at Kingstonian and, after a post denied Bobby Traynor an equaliser, Tony Burke doubled the score with a 27th-minute free-kick.

K's got off the hook in a busy three-minute spell midway through the second half. Sam Clayton pulled a goal back and Wingate's Jordan Fowler was then sent off, the resulting free-kick being lashed home by Tom Bird to make it 2-2.

There was plenty of action at Concord but no end product as they stayed in the bottom four with a 0-0 draw against Carshalton.

Division One North

DIVISION One North leaders Grays were beaten 2-1 at home by Thamesmead after an exciting finish at Rookery Hill on Saturday.

Theo Fairweather-Johnson gave the visitors the lead just before half-time and, with Harry Agombar missing a penalty for Grays, it looked likely to stay that way.

Bradley Thomas thought he had salvaged a point with an 87th-minute header but then home keeper Andy Hall was sent off for bringing down Brad Killick and Ashley Proberts made no mistake with the penalty.

Free-scoring Needham Market moved up to second place with a 4-1 home victory over Tilbury, the previous occupants of that position. Dan Thrower gave the Marketmen a second-minute lead, Emiel Aiken replied after 15 minutes and the league's top marksman, Sam Newson, restored the home lead seven minutes before the interval with his 13th league goal and 21st in all.

Tilbury had a slight edge in a sparkling game but the points slipped out of their reach when Duane Wright headed the third in the 80th minute and Danny Bloomfield wrapped it in added time with Needham's 39th goal in 12 league games.

In the other big match at the top, Brentwood moved up to fourth with two unanswered goals at Waltham Forest. Dean Green headed the opener on 29 minutes, Ryan Edgar added another before half-time and a red card for Tashan Nicholas 20 minutes into the second half ended Forest's comeback hopes. They slipped from fourth place to eighth.

Leiston occupy the final play-off spot after their 2-0 home win over Great Wakering. Rhys Henry opened the scoring on 26 minutes but they had to wait until the dying moments for David Head's clincher.

That second goal was also the one which allowed Leiston to overtake Enfield Town on goal difference. Town had to settle for a single goal, a 54th-minute free-kick from Leon Osei, at Heybridge though the woodwork twice denied them a second.

Potters Bar moved into the top half of the table with a 1-0 home win over Romford. Brad Harrison got the goal after 65 minutes and, although Fabion Simms was sent off shortly afterwards, Romford could not make the most of their extra man.

Ware climbed off the bottom with a 1-1 home draw against Soham, despite having Vince Rispoli sent off for handling on the line after half an hour. Rhys Madden saved the subsequent penalty and Ricci Crace put Ware ahead six minutes later. Soham had to wait until the 80th minute for Matt Robinson's point-saver.

Ilford are now at the foot of the table after forfeiting an early lead and going down 2-1 at Waltham Abbey. Stephen Opoka's seventh-

minute strike was enough to give the Foxes a half-time lead but Adam Bolle, facing the team with whom he started the season, levelled matters a minute after the restart and Steve Cawley drilled home a 25-yarder to win it.

Sudbury also banked an early goal, by Richard Howell, and that was enough for a home victory over Chatham as goalkeepers Danny Gay and Adam Molloy shone.

Cheshunt played at home for the third successive league match and, having lost the first two by an aggregate of 13-1, bounced back to beat Harlow 2-0. Fouls on Kevin Ashwood led to two penalties in the 50th and 88th minutes, both converted by Josh Hutchinson though on the second occasion only after Bertrand Bossu had parried his initial shot.

Division One South

THE Ryman League's last unbeaten record vanished on Saturday when Division One South leaders Dulwich were beaten 2-0 at Maidstone, who took over at the top.

Early goals did the damage: Shaun Welford, with his 16th of the season in all competitions, and Ellis Green were on target in the first 12 minutes as Stones made it nine wins and a draw in their last ten league games.

Dulwich slipped to third, also falling behind Bognor who won 5-0 at Walton Casuals. It was Mick Sullivan's first game as manager of Casuals but nothing has changed yet: their previous match, Neil Shipperley's last at the helm, was at home to Bognor in the Alan Boon Cup and brought a 5-0 defeat!

Rocks had to wait until the very end of the first half for Chris Breach's opener and it was 20 minutes into the second half before Terry Dodd got the second. After that Bognor ran away with it as Stuart Axten, Jason Prior and Lewis Ide completed the rout.

The other two teams in the top five, Folkestone and Corinthian-Casuals, both drew. It was 0-0 at Folkestone, where Tom Hickman hit the bar for Faversham late in the game, while Casuals drew 1-1 at Chipstead. An error by home keeper Martin Grant, dropping a ball which bounced into the net off teammate Jon Cartledge, gave Casuals the lead midway through the first half but Grant was outstanding after that and Julien Thompson levelled it with 20 minutes left.

Worthing moved up to sixth but will still be wondering how their forfeited their 100 per cent home record against an Eastbourne Town

side who had Jordan Lang sent off as early as the 12th minute. Tom Manton put Revels ahead after 25 minutes but a post denied Tom Lawley a second and Sonny Cobbs grabbed a last-gasp equaliser.

Walton & Hersham are off the bottom thanks to a 52nd-minute goal by Daniel Morris which earned them a 1-0 win at Whyteleafe.

Crawley Down are back at the foot of the table despite taking the lead through Luke Blewden at the start and end of the first half, Richard Sinden's 30-yarder putting Hythe on level terms in between. Two Pat Kingwell goals in three minutes just before the hour gave Hythe a 3-2 lead and that was how it finished, with Mark Zawadski's penalty save from David Cook denying the Kent club a fourth.

Only a superior goal difference is keeping Burgess Hill off the bottom and they, too, failed to hold a lead as they went down 2-1 at home to Ramsgate. Pat Harding gave the Hillians a 13th-minute lead but Mark Lovell equalised with a penalty six minutes later and claimed the winner four minutes before the break.

Another Sussex-Kent clash went Sussex's way as Whitstable were beaten 3-0 at Whitehawk. Josh Jones scored in the tenth minute of each half and Jamahl Hughes netted three minutes before half-time.

Croydon Athletic beat visiting Sittingbourne 2-1 thanks to a late penalty by Jamie England, awarded for a foul on James Fray who had netted the opener on 59 minutes. The Brickies drew level through Ryan Golding with seven minutes left but could not hold on to the point.

FA Cup

TWO Ryman League clubs are through to the first round of the FA Cup after defeating Conference opposition in the fourth qualifying round on Saturday and a third made it into the bag for the draw after earning a home replay on Tuesday.

Redbridge, 14th in Division One North, produced the result of the day with a 2-0 home victory over Conference Premier side Ebbsfleet.

The visitors were on the attack for much of the game but keeper Adam Rafis was rarely troubled as Redbridge gave an outstanding defensive performance.

It was goalless after 77 minutes when manager Terry Spillane decided to take off his talisman, Ben Bradbury, who had scored in all four previous rounds of the FA Cup and in both Motormen's FA Trophy victories as well.

The deadlock was broken two minutes later by a header from Ryan Murray and Joe Gardner made sure with a fierce drive in the 88th minute to see Redbridge through to the first round for the first time under their current name. They reached that stage twice as Ford United.

East Thurrock also pulled off an excellent victory, 2-1 at Conference South side Eastbourne Borough, to book their maiden appearance in the competition proper. Their previous best was in 2003, when their name went into the hat for the first round after a draw with Woking but they lost the replay.

Sam Higgins put Rocks ahead in the 57th minute and Kris Newby added a second with a 73rd-minute penalty. Gary Elphick replied for Eastbourne in the 81st minute but it was not enough to deny Rocks their triumph.

Leatherhead were also in the draw after a 3-3 draw at reigning Ryman League champions Sutton, now lying second in Conference South. The game came to life with a burst of four goals in nine minutes either side of the half-hour mark during which Tanners twice took the lead, through Tommy Hutchings and Elliot Thompson, only from Craig Dundas to reply on each occasion.

Craig Watkins put Sutton ahead in the hour but Tanners levelled matters again in the 69th minute, almost inevitably through Kev Terry who seems to save all his goals for the biggest occasions.

Hendon had a glimpse of glory when Carl McCluskey headed them into the lead after five minutes at Luton. But their hopes were soon to be snuffed out and they finished on the wrong end of a 5-1 scoreline. Aaron O'Connor equalised two minutes later from the spot and James Dance headed the home side in front in the 13th minute, though he was injured in the process and had to be stretchered off. Tommy Wright netted in the 25th minute to make it 3-1 at the interval.

The Ryman Premier side put up a spirited fight but Kevin Maclaren was sent off in the 64th minute when he was shown a second yellow card and that effectively settled the tie. An injury to Jamie Busby reduced Hendon to nine men for a brief period shortly afterwards – but it was long enough for Luton to take full advantage to score twice in a minute.

Division One South side Godalming went down 5-0 at home to Conference South outfit Maidenhead. They held out for 32 minutes before Maidenhead opened their account. It was 2-0 at the interval and the visitors killed the game with a third a minute after the break.
