SUDBURY'S march up the table continued on Tuesday when a 3-2 victory at Maldon lifted them into fourth place, 15 places higher than they were little more than a month ago.

They made a storming start and were 3-0 up after 19 minutes with Nathan Clarke adding to a quick-fire James Baker double.

Given that it had been more than ten hours since an opponent scored against them, that looked a secure position.

But Ollie Berquez soon reduced the arrears and when he converted a penalty just before the interval it meant a nervous second half for Sudbury, who held out under increasing pressure.

Needham Market regained the leadership despite failing to score for the first time in a league match this season, and only the second time in any game. They drew 0-0 in a hard-fought affair at Harlow.

Gavin Johnson had their best effort, a 20-yard volley which was saved at full stretch by giant keeper Bertrand Bossu, while Murat Karagul was inches wide with a shot on the turn from similar distance for Harlow – his last touch before limping off.

Redbridge began the task of reducing the hefty fixture backlog caused by their success in the FA competitions with a 1-1 draw at Chatham.

Vinnie Durrant put them ahead after 19 minutes and Jason Barton equalised four minutes before half-time.

The game between Waltham Abbey and Waltham Forest had to be called off because copper piping at the ground had been stolen.

The game of musical chairs at the top end of the division continued on Wednesday as Grays moved up from fifth to third with a comprehensive 5-0 victory at bottom club Ilford.

They went in front after only three minutes when a mishit shot by Joao Carlos turned into a perfect pass for Anthony Ryan to score with ease.

It was the 56th minute before Grays added to their score, again through Ryan who volleyed home an excellent cross from Joe Sweeney.

Ilford had the bad luck so often associated with struggling clubs shortly afterwards when Danny Gabriel's header hit the inside of a post and ran along the goalline before being cleared.

Craig Pope knocked in a simple third goal from closer range in the 66th minute and another followed three minutes later when Ryan's shot was blocked by home keeper Robert Budd and Sweeney knocked in the loose ball.

David Cowley hit the inside of an Ilford post from an unlikely angle in the 87th minute and Kenny Beaney completed the scoring in added time after a frantic goalmouth scramble.

BOGNOR took over at the top of Ryman South last night with a 2-0 home victory over Faversham. They displaced Dulwich, who are two points behind but now have a game in hand.

The lethal Jason Prior opened the scoring after 14 minutes with his 23rd league goal of the season and Ben Johnson made sure with eight minutes left.

Hythe beat Whyteleafe 4-0 in Kent and moved up to eighth place. Craig Thompson gave them a flying start with a third-minute strike but it was midway through the second half before James Dryden

doubled the score and it was doubled again in added time by Ronnie Dolan and Dryden.

Godalming conceded two early goals at Ramsgate but fought back to draw 2-2.

James Gregory, after seven minutes, and Simon Pettit, after 17, put the Rams in a strong position.

Darren Wheeler replied on the half-hour and Dan Read levelled it 14 minutes from time.

SUFFOLK'S two Premier clubs reached the quarter-finals on Tuesday, but both had to work hard for narrow victories over visitors from Ryman South.

Corinthian-Casuals took the lead at Bury with just over an hour on the clock but Sam Nunn replied three minutes later and John Sands struck eight minutes after that to earn Bury a 2-1 win.

Lowestoft, meanwhile, saw off Dulwich with a single 71st-minute goal from Chris Henderson. The visitors missed a chance to equalise when debutant Shaun Phillips saved a penalty.

East Thurrock entertained Thamesmead in a delayed third-round tie and booked their slot in the last 16 with a 2-0 victory.

A penalty shootout was looming on the horizon before Sam Higgins broke the deadlock in the 72nd minute.

Kye Ruel made sure for Rocks when he added a late second.

Leatherhead and Met Police both departed from the competition on Wednesday, which means that none of last season's League Cup quarter-finalists have reached the same stage of this season's competition.

Maidstone defeated 2010 cup-winners Leatherhead 3-0 in Kent, with Alex Waugh scoring early in each half.

He was already the top scorer in the competition and his tally is now six: no-one else has scored more than three.

Sam Bewick netted the second for the Ryman South club in the 34th minute.

Met Police went down 2-1 at home to Lewes in a clash between two of the top five in the Premier table.

Paul Booth put Lewes ahead after 15 minutes, Jerome Walker equalised for the Police in the 27th minute and Ebbsfleet loanee Alex Stavrinou nabbed what proved to be the Lewes winner five minutes later.
